



BANK AND CREDIT CARD SAFETY

Follow these tips to keep your information safe

1. Practice credit card protection from day one!

- Choose a strong password/pin
- Sign the card
- Set up suspicious activity alerts, if available



2. Keep your account number private

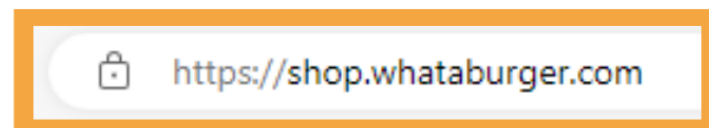
- Don't fall victim to phishing- make sure you know who you're giving personal information to over the phone.
- Keep your card secured and away from the view of others when in public

3. Update your information

- Update your address when you move, so your statements don't end up in the wrong hands

4. Stay safe online

- Avoid using public Wi-Fi for conducting financial transactions
- Never save your card information online
- Shop safe - websites should start with "https" and have a closed lock on the address bar



5. Stay Alert

- Check for signs of tampering prior to inserting or swiping your card at ATMs, gas stations and on pin pads - if it looks suspicious, don't use it
